

Alternates Bylaws Change Recommendation 31Jul11

The purpose of this change is to eliminate Alternate College Representatives.

Current:

- C. College Representatives are designated by their respective Colleges to serve on the AFA Board through communication provided to the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee shall on a yearly basis reconfirm College Representative designation. With Board approval, a College Representative position may be shared by two or more persons provided that only one vote shall be cast between or among those persons. With Board approval, a College Representative may select another Member, who is not a Board member, as an Alternate College Representative (“Alternate”) to represent him/her at a given Board meeting. With Board approval, an alternate may vote at a given Board meeting.

Proposed:
